



Horse Race

Challenger Course
Friday Afternoon

Overview

- \$20 entry fee per person. The house will match the pot, so if all 12 players participate, the pot will be \$240, plus the \$240 match, for a total pot of \$480.
- The horse race will take place on the 9-hole Challenger Course at Bay Hill.
- We will play three foursomes. This round is not part of the Memorial Cup scoring.
- Each player will play his own ball, holing out on every hole and recording a score.
- When all players have completed hole 9, we will meet near the putting green for a live reenactment of the horse race as follows:
 - Holes 1-3: everyone plays as a warm up
 - Hole 4: 2 worst scores eliminated (putt off if needed)
 - Hole 5: 2 worst scores eliminated, (putt off if needed)
 - Hole 6: 2 worst scores eliminated (putt off if needed)
 - Hole 7: 2 worst scores eliminated (putt off if needed)
 - Hole 8: 1 worst score eliminated (putt off if needed)
 - Hole 9: final 3 players compete for the pot
- 1st place: 60% of the pot, 2nd place: 25% of the pot, 3rd place: 15% of the pot
- We will play it live as a 12-some starting on hole 4 if allowed by the Club
- In the event of a tie for the first three places, we will attempt to play extra holes if allowed. If not, we will have a putt off or a chip off.
- Scores will be handicapped as noted to the right.
