



Joshua Cup Participant Agreement

- The Joshua Cup Jr. Team Match Play Championship will be contested in accordance with USGA rules and Step by Step Golf local rules. Players and caddies are expected to honor the rules of the tournament to the best of their ability and to seek assistance from their captain, playing competitors, and rules officials when needed.
- The playing format, tee assignments, and scoring of each round are all critical components of this tournament. It is the responsibility of each player and caddie to understand these details. Players and caddies agree to attend the “Tournament Overview Meeting” to be held virtually approximately one week prior to the event.
- All activities related to this event will honor the values of Step by Step Golf, which can be found online [HERE](#). Players, caddies, team captains, rules officials, family members and guests are expected to honor the spirit of the tournament by competing fiercely but fairly and with the highest level of respect for all involved.
- Players, caddies, family members, and guests are choosing to participate in this event during the Covid-19 pandemic. Step by Step Golf will make every effort to honor social distancing guidelines, particularly at the Welcome Meeting and Family Fellowship Gathering. With both of these meetings being held indoors, attendance by players and caddies at these meetings is 100% voluntary. All participants and attendees are asked to do their part in honor social distancing. Players and caddies agree to hold harmless 1) Step by Step Golf and its representatives, 2) Southern States Jr. Golf Outings and its representatives, and 3) RTJ Golf Trail and its representatives.
- Players and caddies understand this is a team event requiring a field size that is divisible by four (each match is 2 vs 2). Withdrawals have a significant impact on the team and the competition due to the planning required. Players and caddies are asked to be fully committed, with obvious exceptions for family emergencies, illness, and other similar reasons.
