

# STEP by STEP GOLF

## *Participant's Agreement*

**Attendance:** Please treat your registration seriously. Remember, many of the SBSG tournaments are team events. Your teammates and team captains are counting on you. The tournament format, pairings, and team uniforms have been planned with you in mind. Changes to the field of players, and to the team assignments, especially as we get closer to the event create last minute work and expenses for the Tournament Staff.

**Itinerary:** Know the itinerary! Be where you're supposed to be before you're supposed to be there.

**Fellowship:** All SBSG tournaments are operated in conjunction with our partner ministry. Each event will include a fellowship event, either via Zoom, or with onsite in-person gatherings. Golf tournament participants are expected to participate in the fellowship activities.

**Spirit of the Tournament:** While it is our goal to operate a highly competitive tournament, it is also our goal to do so in the most professional and mature manner possible. Participants are expected to exhibit class and respect in all situations, including competitive situations, rules questions, or other scenarios. Participants in violation of the spirit of the tournament may be subject to disqualification and asked to leave the premises.

**Tournament Details:** It is the responsibility of each participant to know the tournament format, points, and rules. Players must also take responsibility for knowing their tee assignments and familiarizing themselves with the Local Rules and daily Notices to Players.

**Withdrawal/Refund Policy:** Withdrawals must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Director. Similar to purchasing sporting event tickets, or concert tickets, tournament entry fees are considered non-refundable. In limited cases, substitute players may be allowed if first approved with the Tournament Committee. In that case, the withdrawing player and the substitute player may work out the details of the repayment.

**Alcohol Policy:** While it is not the intention of SBS Golf to control or regulate personal choices related to alcohol consumption, we respectfully ask all players, caddies, and participants to refrain from consuming alcohol during the times in which you are engaged in group activities. This mainly refers to the time in which you are on the golf course or in attendance at a ministry gathering. Please use discretion and do your best to honor the spirit of the event at all times. Abuse of this policy may result in disqualification and/or dismissal from the event.
